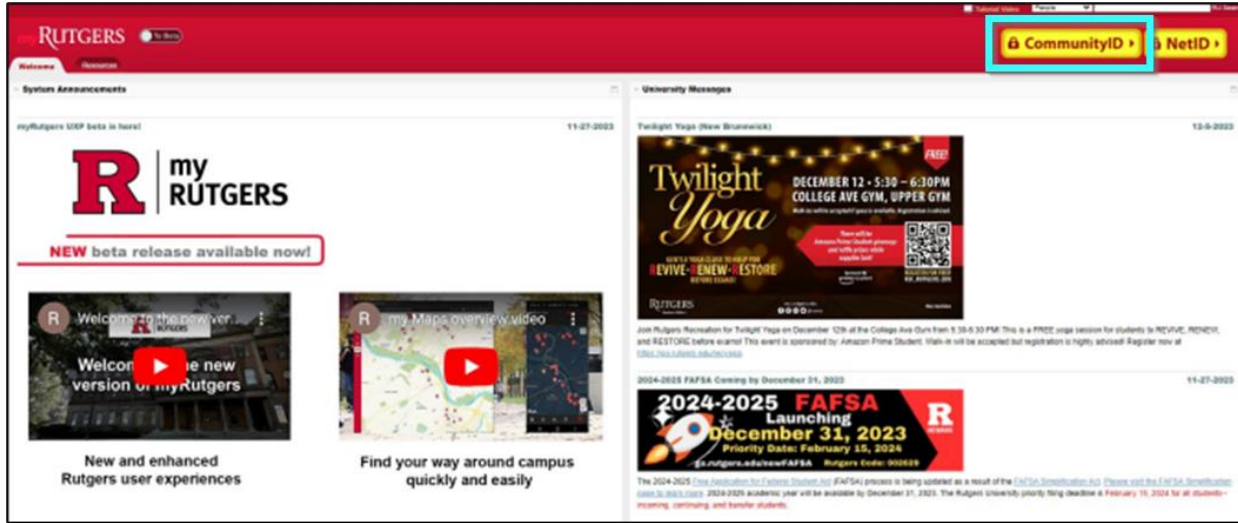
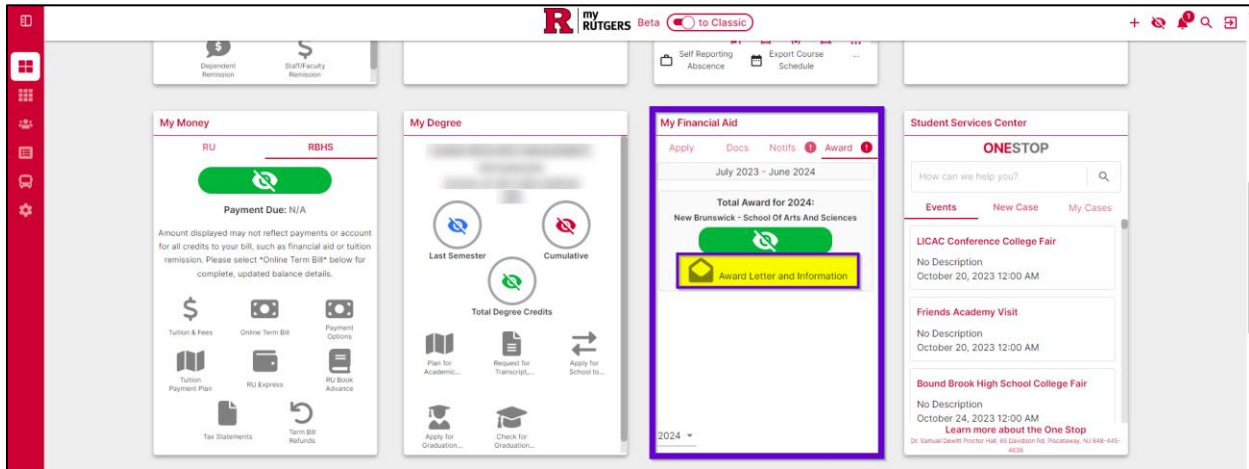


## How to View Student Financial Aid Awards

- Once you have been granted Authorized User access by a student and created your Community ID, log in to your myGuest dashboard at [my.rutgers.edu](https://my.rutgers.edu) and click on the student card to launch the student dashboard.



- Navigate to the *My Financial Aid* widget and click *Award Detail and Information* on the *Award* tab to open the Financial Aid Portal.



- Click on the *Financial* tab.



4. Item 1 will show the student’s estimated cost of attendance calculated by their selection of campus and school, housing preference, textbooks, as well as additional campus fees.
