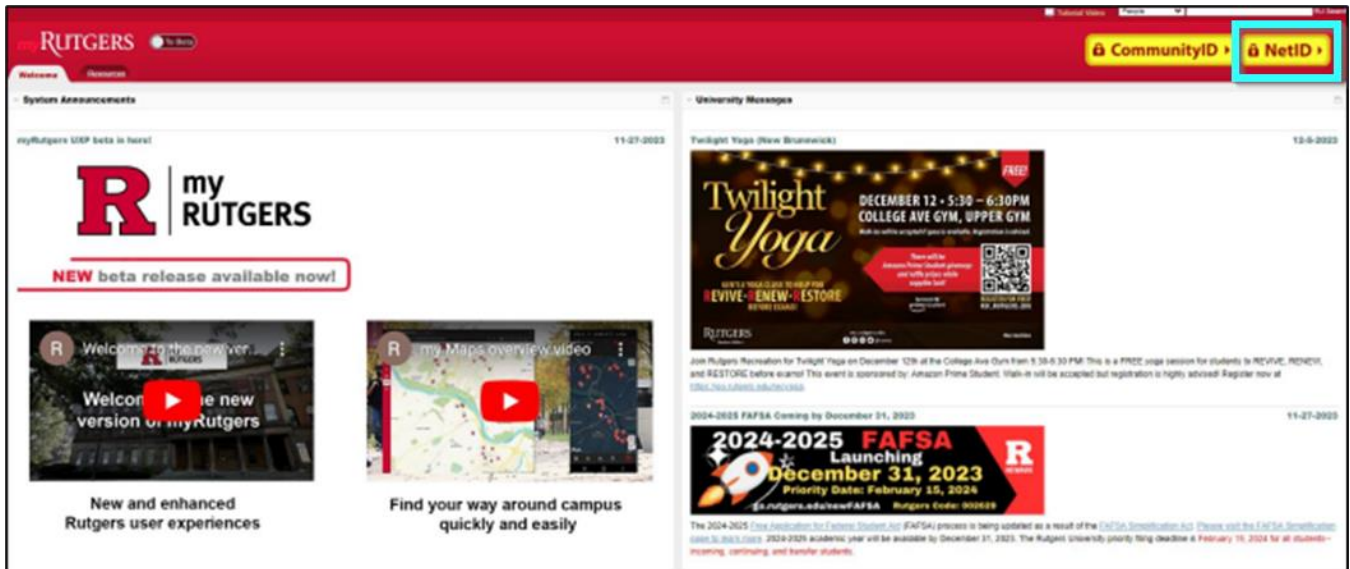


How to View Your Financial Aid Awards

1. Log into your myRutgers account and open the financial aid portal.



2. Click on the *Financial* tab.



- Item 1 will show your estimated cost of attendance calculated by your selection of campus and school, housing preference, textbooks, as well as additional campus fees.
