

## **Kevin Apuzzio Endowed Memorial Scholarship**

## **Scholarship Overview & Eligibility**

The Kevin Apuzzio Endowed Memorial Scholarship is awarded to students with emergency services experience as they work to complete their Rutgers degree and pursue their future endeavors. Students who are emergency services volunteers at the University and/or outside of the University are eligible to apply through Rutgers, University Enrollment Services application process.

To be eligible, students must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher (incoming freshman or transfer students must have final transfer GPA of 2.5 or higher).
- 2. Must be a NJ Firefighter 1 and/or NJ EMT-B/P certified and active on a fire company or EMS agency for more than 18 months.

To apply, student applicants should complete the application form below and send it, along with the following documents, to ues scholarships@ues.rutgers.edu:

- 1. A letter of good standing from a chief or highest-ranking officer of students' affiliated organization.
- 2. A copy of the applicant's NJ Firefighter 1 and/or EMT certification.

Applications should be submitted by July 1 each year.
